It was a great privilege to audit and monitor the Rotary Global Grant implemented by RC Bombay North in Muni Seva Ashram, Vadodara Gujarat. This project is creating a huge impact by establishing a Vocational Training Centre inside the Ashram which is providing varieties of technical education & training to more than 3000 people every year. When we think about Ashram, we assume it would be a small plot of land and a house providing the social services. However, this Ashram is more than what our mind can assimilate. This Ashram has its residential high school, Vocational Training Centre (VTC), School of Nursing, home for differently abled girls, orphanage, dignified home for senior citizens above 65 years and one of the best cancer hospitals in India named as Kailash Cancer Hospital & Research Centre.

They have created the best integrated model for creating a not-for-profit sustainable organization by serving a community at a very nominal charge. I am overwhelmed by the impact that the Muni Seva Ashram has made to the community of Baroda and overall Gujarat.

Celebration of 75 glorious years of our independence

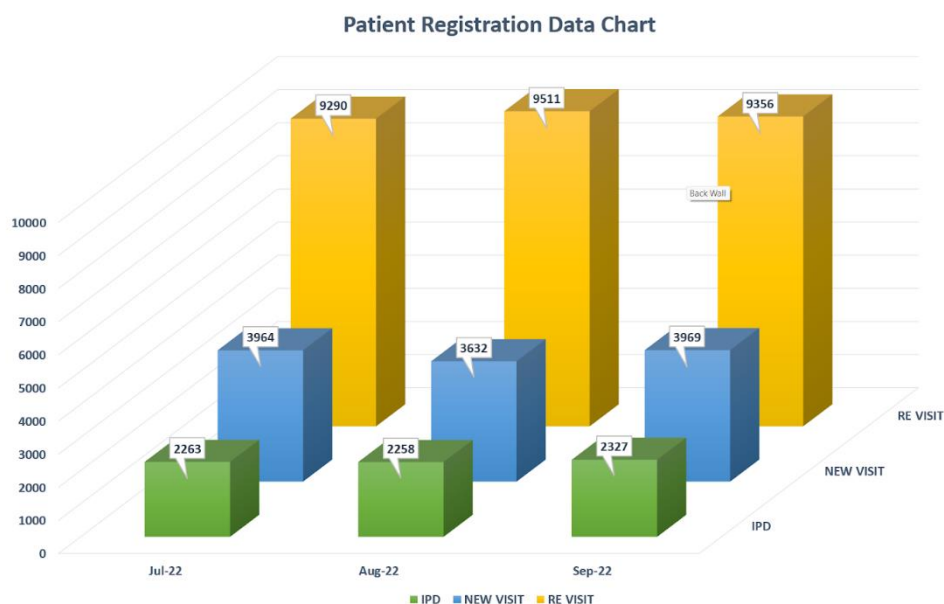
As per the Government circular regarding the celebration, to keep the flame of patriotism alive among the children, our schools took various initiatives to celebrate this event. The contribution of our great freedom fighters and other countrymen is always appreciated with gratitude.

In each of our schools, morning assembly was conducted on the theme of “Aazadi ka Amrut Mahotsav;” Thought, Quiz, Speech, Facts etc were based on the country’s freedom struggle and patriotism. HEALTH CARE

CANCER PREVENTION & EARLY DETECTION – A NEW PROGRAM

This project serves multiple objectives:

- To educate children about the addictive & harmful effects of tobacco so they don't start this bad habit. Workshops will be conducted in village schools (primary and secondary) to educate students about the benefits of early detection of eye diseases, Dental hygiene, and head & neck cancers. The students would be asked to bring their parents to the mobile clinic.
- Diagnostic Mobile Clinic:
 - a. Oral/dental check-ups would be conducted by a dentist for early detection of cavities and other abnormalities. If cancer lesions are suspected, the person will be sent to the H&N team for further investigation. If in doubt, a biopsy sample will be taken free of charge.
 - b. Optometrist Team: Conduct eye tests to diagnose issues such as vision loss & cataracts. Free eyeglasses will be given to the children if needed.
 - c. Breast Tumor Team: Trained staff will teach how to do a self-breast exam. If allowed, staff will perform a breast exam to check for tumors. If a mass is suspected, the person will come to the hospital for full mammography, free of charge.
 - d. Pap Smear Swab Collection Team: Collect pap smear samples of participating women. They will be rewarded with a mango-tree sapling at a discounted price.

The oral biopsy samples & PAP smears would be processed by our lab free of charge.



EDUCATION

SHARDA MANDIR BAXI PANCH ASHRAM SHALA

(Primary School)

Shala Praveshotsav was launched in Gujarat by Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel to encourage parents to enrol their kids in primary schools in the state. This program intended to reduce the dropout rate of students, which has reduced drastically to 3.07% from 37.22% in 2002. At our primary school, the function was held in presence of I.C.D.C of Waghodia Mumtazben & Education Inspector Mr Rakeshbhai Suthar and Mr Kiransing Rajput on June 23, 2022. Twenty boys & seven girls were admitted to 1st Standard. Students were welcomed with sweets & school kits along with school bags, books, notebooks & compass boxes. The function was held in presence of I.C.D.C of Waghodia Mumtazben & Education Inspector Mr Rakeshbhai Suthar and Mr Kiransing Rajput on June 23, 2022. MEDICAL EVENTS

In schools run by the ashram, we look after the overall healthy development of our students, both physical & mental. As part

of it, we arrange Dental check-ups, Eye check-ups and cancer awareness camps once a year in all our schools.



Dental check-ups will help our school children to keep their oral health in good condition & dentist will also monitor their teeth development, provide a thorough cleaning to combat decay and apply dental sealants to protect their teeth from cavities.



Eye Check-ups for children are very important to ensure they have no vision problems that could interfere with school performance and potentially affect their safety. We provide free spectacles to students who need them.



Cancer Awareness & Preventive Care Program: Children are educated in preventive healthcare. Different age group children are given information and knowledge using relevant educational materials and useful methods.

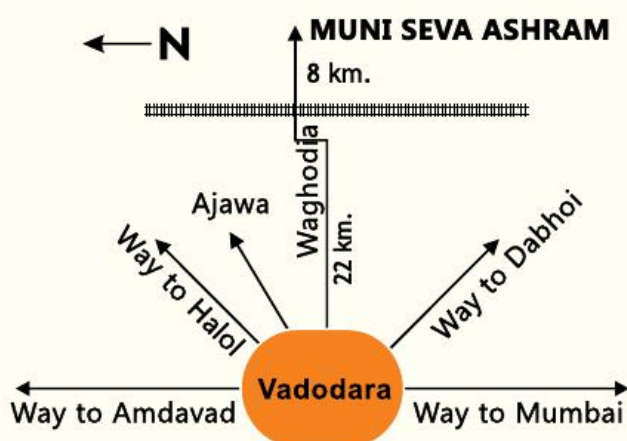
